Chagall created the motif as the frontispiece for Elsa Triolet's book "La Mise en Mot", Editions Skira, Geneva 1969.

The colours in this work and its charming, whimsical imagery form a perfect harmony for the cover of Elsa Triolet's book. The vibrant shades of pink accentuate the vivid green grass, both set against a beautiful blue sky. The yellow tones pop from the page, emphasising this bold, bright impression.

Triolet was a passionate French writer who later married Louis Aragon, also a writer. They drew inspiration from the flourishing literary movement in Russia and France and befriended many artists who helped them visualise their works.
